

Twitter Contest Terms and Conditions

The 2017-2018 @westernuSE Twitter contest, (hereafter known as "Contest") is a contest run by Student Experience at The University of Western Ontario (hereafter known as "Authorized Party"). License

By becoming a registered "follower" of @westernuSE on Twitter and in consideration of the opportunity to win prize(s), you agree to allow publication rights in perpetuity of your Twitter username and real name to the Authorized Party.

By entering the Contest, all entrants grant an irrevocable perpetual, nonexclusive license to the Authorized Party, to reproduce, publish, display, distribute the Twitter username of the entries in connection with the contest and promotion of the Contest, and for purposes or promotion, advertising, and trade of publications owned, operated, controlled, published or distributed by the Authorized Party. The Authorized Party will not be required to pay any additional consideration or seek any additional approval in connection with such use.

Judging

A winning Twitter user will be chosen at random; for example, by potentially using the software *Twitrand* (www.twitrand.com) to ensure impartiality. If it is evident that the user selected is ineligible to win, determined by Student Experience, then that user will be removed/excluded and a new winner will be chosen.

Prizes

There will be multiple prize draws throughout the 2017/2018 academic year. Entrants will be informed of deadlines and prizes as the contest approaches.

In the event that a selected entrant does not meet or comply with these Contest Terms and Conditions, or cannot be contacted within two weeks of his/her selection, an alternative entrant will be selected from the remaining entries. The prizes must be accepted as awarded, are non-transferable and cannot be redeemed for cash. All federal, provincial and municipal taxes are the sole responsibility of the winner.

The draw will take place after the contest closes. Winners will be notified through direct messaging using Twitter.com.

To claim a prize, the selected entrant must agree to these Terms in Conditions.

Prizes must be claimed no later than 90 days after the selected entrant is notified of his or her winning entry. In the event that the selected entrant does not claim the prize in the allotted time period, he or she will forfeit the prize.

Eligibility

This Contest is open to all current students at The University of Western Ontario and current employees of The University of Western Ontario with the exception of those that are employed by The Office of the Registrar, Teaching Support Services, Student Services Support Group, or Student Experience.

The selected entrant must be able to prove that he/she is the sole person responsible for and has access to the selected Twitter account and/or Instagram account. Organizations and groups are ineligible.

The Authorized party reserves the right to change the terms, conditions and notices under which this Contest is offered.
